COMMISSION DESIRE TO CONSIDER AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING TRAINING

- First raised by Commissioner Ananda February 2018
- April City Manager's Report
- August City Manager's Report
 - CC expressed interest in having the item returned for discussion
- What is SafeBar training?

CITY CODE

- **4-106 LICENSES REQUIRED.** It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or serve any alcoholic liquor on any premises within the City unless the person owning or operating that premises has obtained from the City Clerk a valid license to sell and serve alcohol on that premises, has a current, valid City license to sell and serve alcohol on that premises, and is licensed by the State of Kansas to sell and serve alcohol on that premises.
- **4-108 QUALIFICATION FOR PRIVATE CLUB OR DRINKING ESTABLISHMENT CITY LICENSE.** (A) The Governing Body of the City shall, if the applicant is qualified by law, issue a license to the applicant. (B) A city license shall not be issued to an applicant unless such applicant is in compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 41-2601 et seq. (C) A city license shall not be issued to an applicant unless such applicant is in compliance with the provisions of Section 4-112.

WICHITA'S EXAMPLE

- Implemented training requirement in 2009
- 4 hour class
- State ABC, Fire Department, Wichita's PD participate
- Topics are City code, Fire code, and State laws.
- Sexual assault is discussed but is not an overarching theme in the training.
 - Includes over-service that can lead to sexual assault
 - Regular battery v. sexual battery

STAFF FOLLOW-UP SINCE AUGUST

- Met with Care Center to discuss how the training would look
 - Invited 165 on premise licensees:
 - Requests made during the meetings --
 - Data
 - Request to delay a vote
 - Include SafeBar training as part of the voluntary annual compliance training

ANNUAL COMPLIANCE TRAINING

- **Provided annually in August**
- Lawrence Art Center free of charge
- The Lawrence PD schedules and coordinates the training.
- **Topics**
 - Fire Department --- safety and codes compliance
 - City Prosecutor segment on applicable criminal laws.
 - ABC – provides the remaining bulk of the training and focuses on state liquor laws, ABC regulations, features of the KS driver's license, and detection of fake IDs.

ANNUAL COMPLIANCE TRAINING ATTENDANCE

- **2018** – 49 people attended.
- **2017** – 40 people attended.
- **2016** – No training provided
- **2015** – 115 people attended.

NEXT STEPS

- **Next Steps**
 - Who would be required to attend the SafeBar training?
 - How often should the training be required?
 - How will the cost of the training be handled?
 - What is the effective date of the ordinance?
 - Should licensees who have voluntarily participated within the previous 6 months – 1 year be able to use that training once an ordinance is effective?
 - Should the proposed ordinance exclude the training requirement for any person applying for a temporary liquor license, in which there is typically a single event that lasts less than one day?
