A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS AND DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS ESTABLISHING THE PARTICIPATION PERCENTAGE RATE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY OF LAWRENCE AND DOUGLAS COUNTY RESPECTIVELY FOR THE OPERATIONS OF THE FIRE AND MEDICAL DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 65-6113 authorizes the governing body of any municipality, including any city or county, to establish, operate and maintain an emergency medical service or ambulance service as provided by K.S.A. 65-6101 et seq. ("the Act") as a municipal function and may contract with another municipality for the purpose of furnishing emergency medical services or ambulance services within or without the boundaries of the municipality upon such terms and conditions and for such compensation as may be agreed upon; and

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-2908 <u>et seq.</u>, and amendments thereto, authorizes the parties hereto to contract to perform any governmental service, activity or undertaking which each contracting city or county is authorized by law to perform;

WHEREAS, the City and County did enter into a cooperation agreement on December 16, 1996 (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") and

WHEREAS, the City and County duly amended the Agreement to require adoption of a resolution establishing the percentage rate of the total department budget to paid by the City and County respectively.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS:

Pursuant to Section 5 of the Agreement, the annual percentage rates of the total Department budget for the operation of the Fire and Medical Department shall be established as follows: the City shall pay seventy four and thirty six hundredths percent (74.36%) of the total Department budget, and the County shall pay twenty-five and sixty four hundredths percent (25.64%). The percentage rates established by this Resolution shall remain effective for annual budgeting purposes until amended by a Joint Resolution adopted by the City and County.
