

ORDINANCE NO. 9204

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS, PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF GLASS BOTTLES OR OTHER GLASS CONTAINERS ON CERTAIN STREETS AND PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY AT CERTAIN TIMES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to the general police powers of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, in order to promote the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens, it shall be unlawful, from 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 26, 2016, through 6:00 a.m. on Monday, March 28, 2016, and beginning again at 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 2, 2016, through 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 5, 2016, to carry or to possess glass bottles or other glass containers on the following streets and public rights-of-way: New Hampshire Street (between Sixth Street and Thirteenth Street), Massachusetts Street (between Sixth Street and Thirteenth Street), and Vermont Street (between Sixth Street and Thirteenth Street).

**SECTION 2.** Any person who violates this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).


**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication as provided by law.


