

ORDINANCE NO. 9336

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS, PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF GLASS BOTTLES OR OTHER GLASS CONTAINERS ON CERTAIN STREETS AND PUBLIC RIGHTS-OF-WAY AT CERTAIN TIMES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF LAWRENCE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the general police powers of the City of Lawrence, Kansas, in order to promote the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens, it shall be unlawful, from 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 25, 2017, through 6:00 a.m. on Monday, March 27, 2017, and beginning again at 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 1, 2017, through 6:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 4, 2017, to carry or to possess glass bottles or other glass containers on the following streets and public rights-of-way: New Hampshire Street (between Sixth Street and Thirteenth Street), Massachusetts Street (between Sixth Street and Thirteenth Street), and Vermont Street (between Sixth Street and Thirteenth Street).

SECTION 2. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication as provided by law.
