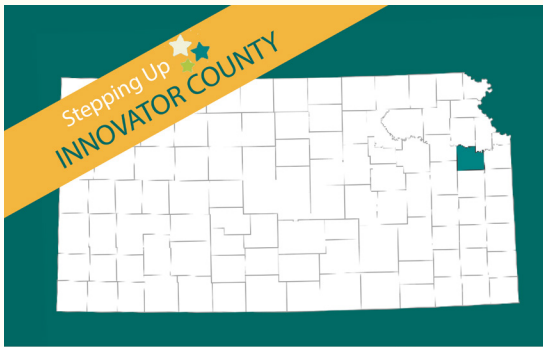


Stepping Up to reduce mental illness in the Douglas County Correctional Facility
