



### WE ARE ONE

**W**E ARE ONE is a sculpture featuring five intricately carved stones symbolizing unity. Shaped into a hand from vibrant marbles from Portugal, the U.S., Italy, and Spain, the structure rests on a 6-foot Kansas limestone pedestal, stands 9 feet tall, and weighs 5200 pounds. The inscription "We Are One" underscores its themes of unity, inclusion, and diversity.

Schachter started sculpting in 1995 under the tutelage of renowned KU Professor and artist Eldon Tefft. He worked as an assistant in Tefft's bronze foundry where he was introduced to stone sculpting. He and Professor Tefft then started biannual workshops in stone carving, which has continued for 24 years with about 50 attendees at every session.
