STUDY IN LIGHT is a curved steel monolith with offset holes that are lined with polished stainless steel. The sculpture is oriented to best capture the shadows of light reflecting through polished stainless steel throughout the day and night.

Retired master mechanic and visionary renaissance man, Pat Slimmer is also the creator of the infamous "Flying Saucer" Art Car. This signature vehicle seen in Lawrence's annual the Art Tougeau parade has also traveled to many exhibitions and has been featured in several books.
