Personnel

The Lawrence Percolator used 10 volunteers for the 6 hour event. The Lawrence Community Shelter provided 200 volunteer hours for the creation of the permanent murals. The Kansas in-kind volunteer rate is 18.13 per hour. $260 \times 18.13 = \$4713.80$.

LCAC grant funds were distributed to 4 Caravan artists. \$300.00 to the lead muralist KT Walsh, \$100.00 each for Lead Artists Michael Bradley and Tommee Sherwood, and \$50.00 each to artists Sora Korso and Irene Tsuneta for contributions to the Caravan event.

Total Supplies: \$350.00




