- 1) Describe the outcome(s) of this project
The LCAC grant made it possible for Lawrence Public Library, in partnership with Downtown Lawrence, Inc., to offer the *2018 Dinner and a Movie* series. It allowed us the opportunity to provide four family-friendly events that were free and open to everyone in Lawrence. The City was one of four sponsors in the series. Approximately 1,300 people attended the series in 2018.

- 3) Estimate how many people benefited from this project: 400 adults 900 children
How did you collect these numbers? These were crowd estimates. The Library and DLI have hosted the *Dinner and a Movie* series for four years and have reliable crowd estimate experience.
- 4) Describe what the LCAC grant enabled you to accomplish in regard to this project.
The *Dinner and a Movie* series featured two summer movies on the Library Lawn and two fall and winter movies at Abe & Jake's Landing. The four movies shown were: *Moana* (6/2/18); *Coco* (8/18/18), *Frankenweenie* (10/11/18) and *Elf* (12/13/18). Downtown Lawrence restaurants also sold food and snacks at these events, while DLI raffled off free prizes. In addition, there was live music as pre-movie entertainment. This series helped to advance the goals identified by the Lawrence community in the City Wide Cultural Plan. We "Balance the Local" by supporting local businesses as vendors and as screening locations. We "Embrace All/Celebrate Community" by making these events completely free and open to everyone. We "Build Places Together" by bringing citizens together in community spaces like the Library Lawn and Abe & Jake's Landing. We "Build and Market a Creative Brand" using the now-recognizable *Dinner and a Movie* series that attendees have come to expect and enjoy. Most importantly, the library "Promotes Lifelong Learning" in everything it does.
