1) Describe the outcome(s) of this project					
During Jacqui Russell's time at the Lied Center, she worked with 7 local artists and a consultant to begin the creation of a <i>Red Kite</i> theatre piece that will be focused on Indigenous themes, reflecting the Indigenous cultures of Kansas. The workshop included 5 days of brainstorming and artist training/workshopping to create the ideas for the new piece. Jacqui and her team have returned to Chicago with these ideas to complete the theatre piece. They will continue to be in contact with our consultant, Jancita Warrington to ensure that the work stays true to the themes and ideas that were workshopped with the Indigenous actors. Jacqui and Will will return later in the year to put the piece on the actors with a test audience. Will refine it in consultation with the actors and consultant. They will finish the work in Chicago and will return in April 2020 to put it on the team of artists for the first performances, which will be part of the 2020 KU First Nations Student Association Powwow and Indigenous Cultures Festival.

The workshop involved 7 local artists and an Indigenous consultant. Overall, though, this project will					

benefit many children on the spectrum and their families once it is completed. We will host a free performance at the Indigenous Cultures Festival in 2020, and we plan to tour the work to a few Indigenous reservations throughout Kansas. We also hope to partner with the Kansas Creative Arts Industries

Commission (KCAIC) to make the work part of their touring roster in the future; this would allow for organizations to request funds to bring the theatre piece to their town. It is difficult to estimate just how many children and families this project will ultimately benefit, but we are hopeful that all that are able to participate will find it to be a positive and memorable experience.

4) Describe what the LCAC grant enabled you to accomplish in regard to this project.

The LCAC grant helped us pay local artists' workshopping a new work with the Chicago Children's Theatre's Artistic Director and assistant here in Lawrence. The grant also helped with some of the costs of bringing the CCT Artistic Director and Assistant here for 5 days. We have and continuing to locate funding to complete the entire project. The total cost of the entire project will be around \$30,000.
