- A. Regular Agenda Items
1. Call meeting to order
Chair Katherine Weik called to meeting to order at 7:05.
 2. Minutes
The minutes for meetings held on June 21 and August 9 were approved as distributed.
- B. New Business
1. Mural presentation
Representatives of the Women of Color mural team presented the concept for a mural for the public parking garage south of the Lawrence Public Library. The Commission asked the team to bring back the final design for review at a regular Commission meeting by May, 2018.
 2. Mural presentation
Margot Day presented a mural design inspired by the deaths of Erin and daughter Mazey Berg to encourage people confronted by the prospect of violence or who need social services to call 211 for help. It will be approximately 5' x 5' possibly on the stucco wall of Ernst Hardware in the mid-800 block alley near the Cultural Diversity mural. The Commission voted to approve the mural pending completion of the application by Wednesday, October 12 for consideration by the City Commission and pending a letter of approval from the owner of the wall.
 3. Location for annual retreat
The Spencer Museum of Art will host the Commission's annual planning retreat on Sunday, January 7, 2018 from 1:00 to 4:00 pm.

1. ArtPlace Grant update

Porter provided an update on the status of this grant originally designated for the E. 9th Street project. He will contact Cindy Maude at the Lawrence Arts Center about the possibility of using grant funds for art on the Lawrence Loop. The Commission voted that at this point no representatives of the Cultural Arts Commission including the Arts and Culture Director will participate in any further meetings about this grant until such time as the Lawrence Arts Center may submit an application to the Commission for review and approval of art intended for public spaces.

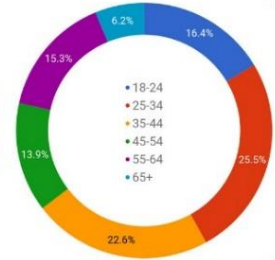
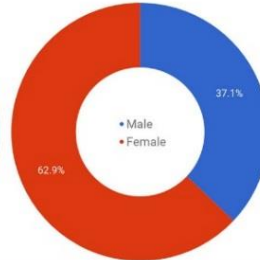
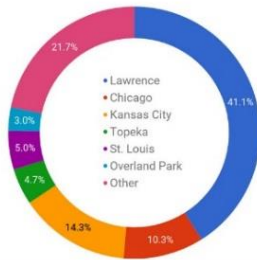
