A. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 4:12pm. Introductions were made. There was not a quorum.

Transit Manager Hiring Update - Discussion Item

Brandon McGuire, Assistant City Manager updated PTAC on the recruitment process for a new Transit Manager. He asked PTAC members to weigh in on what's going well and things that should be considered for improvements as staff work on hiring a new manager.

2. Transit Center and Amenities - Discussion Item

Brandon McGuire shared that City staff have a drafted memorandum of understanding (MOU) with KU in order to move forward on preliminary analysis of the site by the City. The MOU is expected to go to the City Commission by the end of 2019.

Brandon McGuire introduced Dustin Smith, as the project engineer assigned to manage the transit center design and development process.

Jessica Mortinger noted that we are awaiting amenities to be installed. Wendy Koerner explained that there are 20 sites that are planned for amenities.

Brandon McGuire mentioned Velocity Church has donated \$10,000 to the City of Lawrence for transit amenities and be put to the best use. The money will be most likely used for benches.
