### FoH (Friends of Hiratsuka)--Johnson

- Mayor sent a letter to Mayor Boley on his selection as mayor.

## FoE (Friends of Eutin)--Scholz

- Scholz provided an update on the report for the Consul General. Photos are being collected and permissions obtained.
- The Friends of Lawrence in Eutin have new leadership with Dr. Stephan Klein as chair and Annegret
  Klein as secretary of Freunde von Lawrence. Keel will request a letter of congratulations from the city.

- Mayor Boley plans to visit Eutin this summer while the students are there.
- Scholz indicated that Herr Klein would like a video clips from Lawrence friends as part of a gift for Martin and Marion Vollertsen, the outgoing chairs at German-American night. Discussion on how to produce the video took place.
- Niccum and Scholz were appointed to explore video production.

  - Schumm moved and Scholz seconded that this draft be submitted to the Mayor.
  - Fales moved that we select a date for a general meeting in place of a board meeting,.

Next meeting tentatively May 16, 2018 at 5:30 P.M. but a general membership meeting of Sister Cities Lawrence will be scheduled to adopt bylaws and elect a Governing Board.
