


## Travel Demand Model – Base Year









## Travel Demand Model – No Build 2040










# Federal Functional Classification & Major Thoroughfares

The Federal Functional Classification Map is a federally mandated map with certain requirements & is used on a state and national level for funding eligibility.

The Major Thoroughfares Map is used by Lawrence and Douglas County to balance land access and thru movement of traffic for network level planning. Network planning ensures connectivity and access, as well as guides local decisions on corridor preservation, access management, and roadway design.

## Projects & Strategies - Multimodal

## Encourage safe and efficient traveling through the multimodal networks

- Integrate multimodal elements in project planning, design, construction, and maintenance, consistent with the Complete Streets Policy
- Plan and implement citywide multimodal wayfinding
- Prioritize crash (vehicle and non-motorized) hot spots for safety improvements
- Strength and implement access management for all users
- Facilitate, develop, and distribute safety education programming/materials for all users


## Continue a transparent and coordinated transportation planning process that encourages participation and performance based planning

#### **Background**

Several funding sources are available for the pedestrian, bicycle and ramp projects for 2017 and 2018. Projects that will be constructed with these funds must be identified so that staff can proceed with the solicitation for design service. The funding sources are:

- 2017 CDBG ADA Ramps \$93,000
- 2017 CDBG 16<sup>th</sup> and Haskell Crossing \$45,000
- 2017/2018 Sidewalk/Bike/Ped Improvements/ADA Ramps (funding split approved at Feb 5, 2018 meeting)
  - o \$350,000 Bikeways
  - o \$150,000 Sidewalk Gaps/Ped Improvements
  - o \$100,000 ADA Ramps
- 2018 CDBG \$240,200 (recommended by Community Development Advisory Committee, still needs approval by City Commission)

Staff has used the approved Non-Motorized Projects Prioritization Policy to rank all of the applicable projects and has also put together planning level estimates for several of the potential projects. Based on the rankings and available funding, staff has developed a recommended spending plan for the funds that is outlined below.

#### **Details**

#### ADA Ramps

- > 2017/2018 ADA Ramps Funds
  - \$18,000 Design for 2017 CDBG ramps
  - \$82,000 Design and construction of ramps along the designated Safe Routes to School for New York Elementary
- > 2017 CDBG ADA Ramps Funds
  - \$93,000 Construction of ramps along 11<sup>th</sup> St from Massachusetts St to Burroughs Creek Trail

#### **Bikeways**

- ➤ 2017/2018 Bike Improvements Funds
  - \$350,000 for design and construction of the following projects:
    - Bike Boulevard on 21st St from Iowa St and Naismith Dr
    - Bike Boulevard on 21<sup>st</sup> St from Naismith Dr to Massachusetts St
    - Bike Boulevard on Lawrence Ave from Harvard Rd to Bob Billings Pkwy

#### **Sidewalk Gaps/Ped Improvements**


- ➤ 2017 CDBG 16<sup>th</sup> and Haskell Crossing Funds
  - Originally proposed as a Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon, however, staff proposes changing it to a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) because it is more cost effective (FHWA issued new interim approval of RRFB's on 3/20/18)
  - Design would be paid for using the 2017/2018 ped improvement funds.
- ➤ 2017/2018 Sidewalk Gap/Ped Improvements Funds
  - \$5,000 for design of RRFB at 16<sup>th</sup> and Haskell
  - \$145,000 for design and construction of the following projects:
    - East side of Michigan St, 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> (P083)
    - South side of W. 27<sup>th</sup> St, Crestline to Chipperfield (P088)
    - South side of Harvard Rd, Iowa to Hilltop (P141)
- > 2018 CDBG Funds
  - \$240,200 for design and construction of the following projects:
    - South side of E 19<sup>th</sup> St, Barker to Moodie (P002,P003,P004,P068)
    - South side of E 15<sup>th</sup> St, Haskell to Maple (P147)
    - East side of Ousdahl Rd, W 19<sup>th</sup> to W 23<sup>rd</sup> (P092)




