Grant Objectives

1.Non Violent Communication	Children's groups at The Willow are conducted in a 'safe space' where displays of violence are not appropriate. If/when children display violent communication, they are redirected by advocates and given non violent communication options.
2. Handling Anger Positively	There were no incidents of violent behavior or aggression from children during the reporting period at shelter. Advocates continue to provide children with tools and guidance on how to react differently to situations, and how to understand their emotions, and make appropriate responses.
3.Increased Self Confidence	All the children who completed the rubric scale during this reporting period, reported feeling good about themselves.

Drug and Alcohol Awareness

All children who were in an age appropriate range (4-9 yrs.) who requested drug and alcohol information, or who were assessed as to being able to benefit from this education, completed those activities.
