- C. Did you receive City funding for this program in calendar year 2015? If so, how much? Yes, \$110,000.
 - 1. How would a reduction in city funding in 2016 impact the ability of your agency to provide services to/on behalf of the City? The Lawrence Arts Center would be forced to reduce hours we are open to the public, as well as hours available for facility rentals. There is also the risk of reducing the quality and quantity of programs we have available for the community to enjoy.
 - 2. If you are requesting an increase in funding over 2015, please provide a justification for the increase. Based on the hours of operation of the Arts Center, it is essential that we maintain a full-time facilities manager, a full-time custodian, a part-time custodian, and a part-time technical director. We were pleased to receive a portion of the request we made in 2015, but do need salary dollars to be able to maintain these four positions. Without these positions, we could ensure access to the building on weekends and outside of school and work days. We maintain our commitment to allow use of the facilities at little or no cost to other non-profits and to city and county departments. We do not want to curtail access to the Arts Center for the public due to a lack of staff.
