DMI was reorganized in 2015 with the CVB duties now being handled by eXplore Lawrence, a designated 501-(c) 6 organization. DMI primarily exists currently to support the efforts of Freedom's Frontier National Heritage Area, which is headquartered in Lawrence. In 2015, the City Commission provided funding in the 2016 and 2017 budget cycles to provide DMI with funding to support the salary of the Executive Director of FFNHA with the intention that after these two years FFNHA would generate the funds needed to provide for this position through fundraising and development work. The 2017 funds provided to DMI are being used for this specified purpose.

The total disbursement of funds (\$30,000) from the City were transferred directly to FFNHA for the use requested: funds for the Executive Director's salary.

Yes, two \$15,000 transfers were made in 2017 to FFNHA. This completes the agreement initiated in late 2015 between the City and DMI for this purpose.
