Direction has been given by the LMH WellCare Clinic regarding the utilization of it's services. City Employees and adult family members on the City's Health Insurance who wish to use the LMH Wellness Center must call **785-505-3112** to be screened over the phone by one of the APRNs. How you answer the questions, will determine if you will be seen in the clinic or referred to your Primary Care Physician. The screening questions that will be asked are below.

If you are experiencing any respiratory symptoms such as fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath, significant tiredness, or body aches, please contact the LMH WellCare Clinic or your PCP immediately. Supervisors and managers, if you see someone that is experiencing these symptoms, please have them contact the WellCare Clinic or their PCP immediately.

Also note that LMH has changed it's entrance requirements. There will be screening procedures and limited access to the entrances. Please call the LMH WellCare Clinic prior to going to LMH for instructions.

This is an evolving situation and we will be providing regular updates.
