

## Employee Communication: Coronavirus 2020 Update

For those of you who have been impacted by the city's COVID-19 response, we are working diligently to ensure that you and your families will be taken care of and given access to proper resources during this critical time.

We have secured pay through May 31<sup>st</sup> for all city employees who are not able to report to work or for whom are unable to be placed in temporary work assignments. As we move closer to that date, we will continue to monitor and evaluate the situation to determine what other steps we can take to serve our employees.

Also, the city has removed all caps on vacation and sick time accrual for the duration of the COVID-19 response.
