- 6 Lap lanes

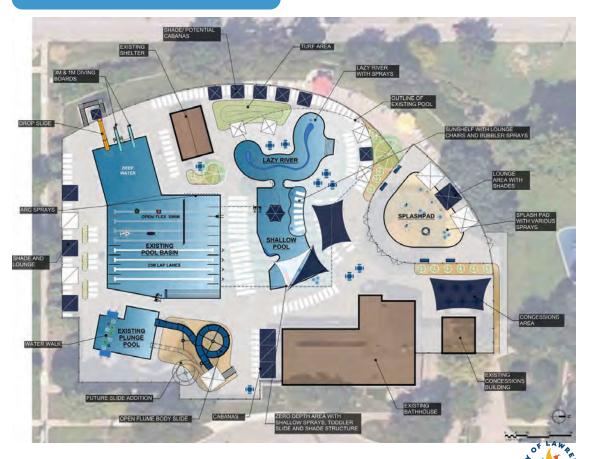

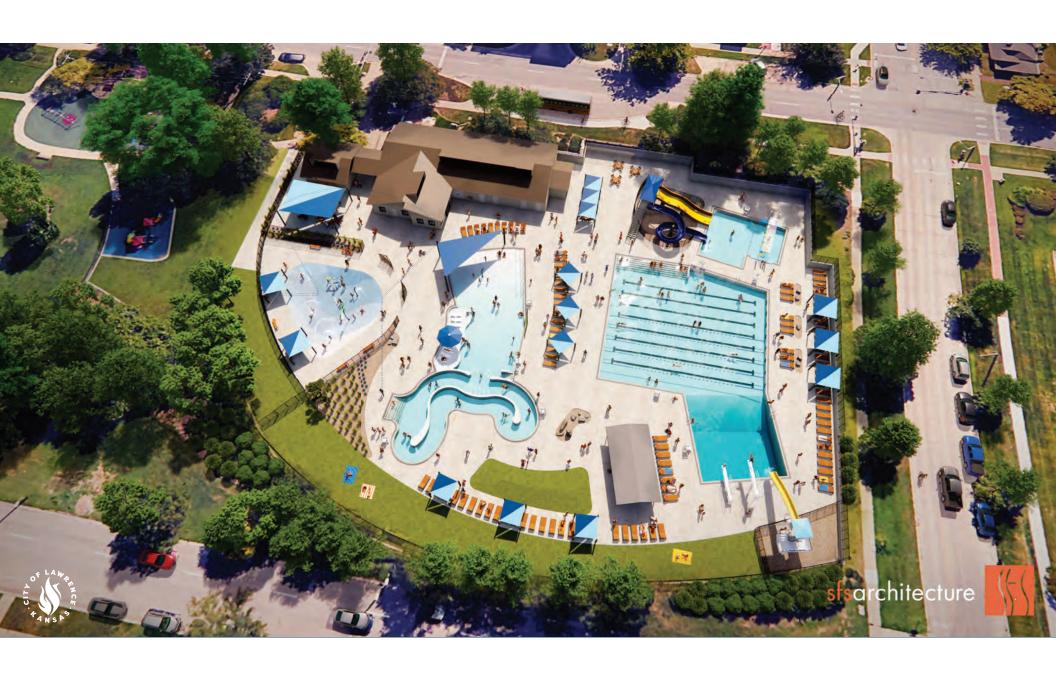

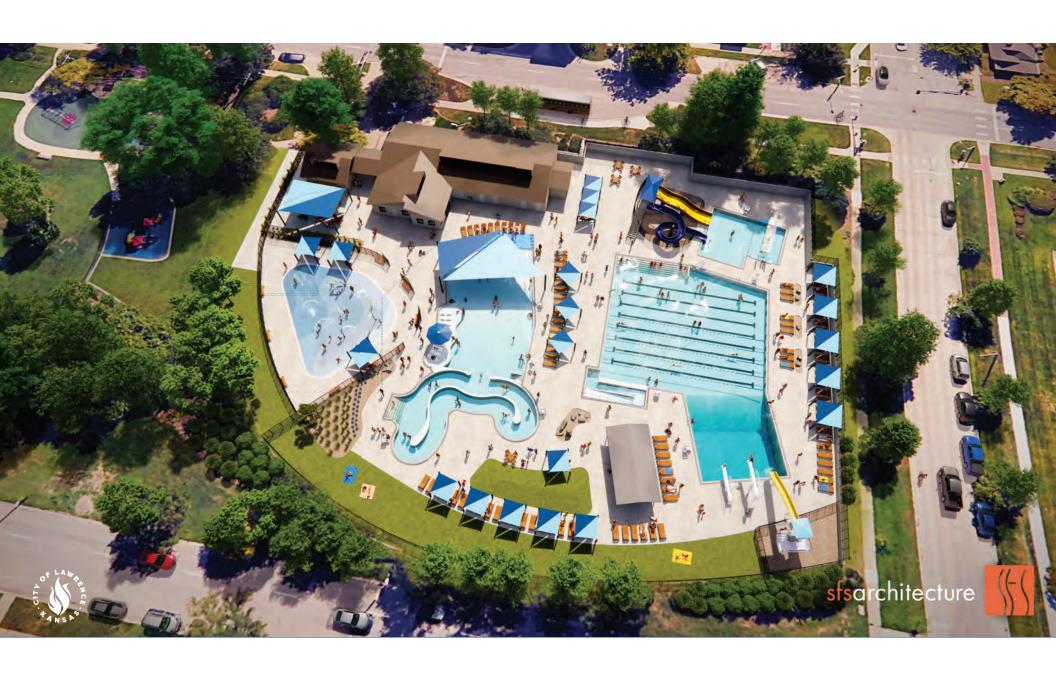

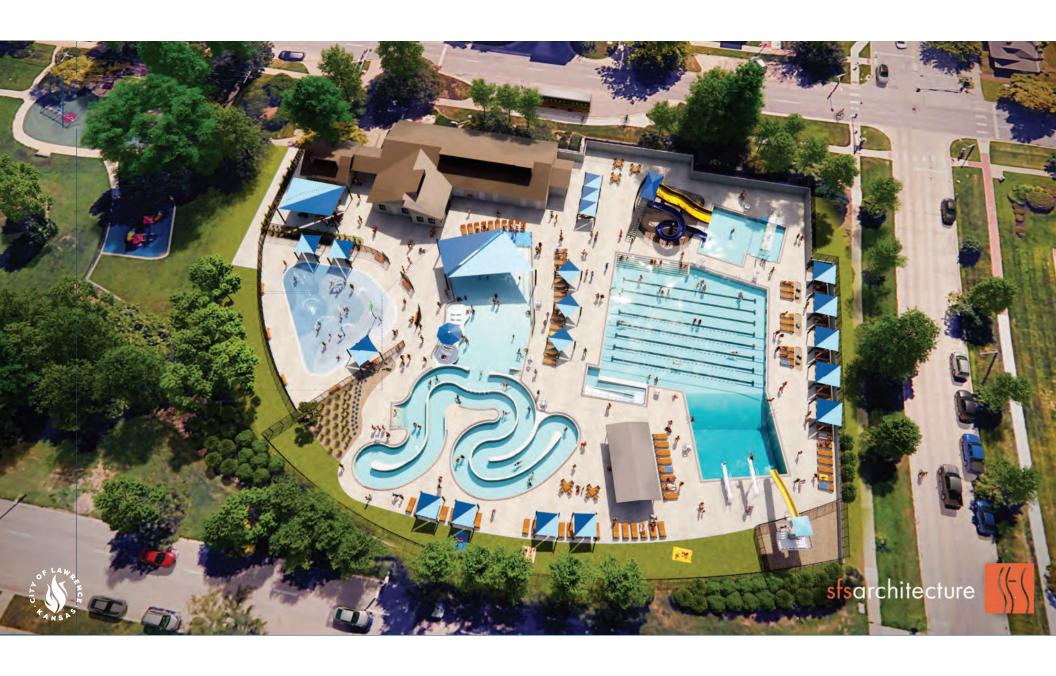
