DOUGLAS COUNTY AMATEUR BASEBALL ASSOCIATION (DCABA)

DCABA has the following divisions: 8 years old and under (U8), 10 years old and under (U10) and 12 years old and under (U12). Each league can accommodate eight teams per division. Final rosters and team payment must be submitted before Friday, March 29, 2013. Teams may play up to other divisions but can not play below their age classification. A player's eligibility is determined by the age they are as of May 1, 2014.

Team Entry Leagues include:

U8 — Two options that are the team's choice.

American League — Coach Pitch. Recommended for 8 year olds and younger first-year DCABA participants.

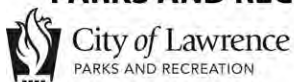
National League — Machine Pitch. Recommended for 8 year olds and/or returning DCABA participants. All players must be at least 8 years old or younger on Tuesday, May 1, 2014, to be eligible for either league.

Both U8 leagues are formed either by a team entry or by adding players to teams still in need of additional players. ALL U8 players must register individually.

U10 — Two options that are the team's choice. Team entry only. Max: 16 teams — 8 teams per league.

American League — National Little League rules. Runners can not leave the base until the ball crosses the plate, no advancement on a dropped third strike. Recommended for first year teams into player pitch.

National League — USSSA baseball rules. Regular lead offs and steals; runners can advance on a dropped third strike. This league is for the more experienced team.

U12 — Two options that are the team's choice. Team entry only. Max: 16 teams — 8 teams per league.

American League — National Little League Rules. Runners cannot leave the base until ball crosses the plate. Recommend for first-year U12 teams.

National League — USSSA baseball rules. Regular lead offs and steals; runners can advance on a dropped third strike. This league is for the more experienced team.

Age limits for all teams in all DCABA leagues are determined by age as of May 1, 2014. Players can play up, but not down. For more information, please contact the Youth Sports office at (785) 832-7940.

LOUIE HOLCOM AMATEUR BASEBALL ASSOCIATION

Heinrich League — Open to the first 8 teams that pay the \$150 team deposit. Balance due April 2, 2014.

Objective of this league is to provide a competitive league schedule for teams wishing to schedule tournaments (on their own) on the weekends. Players can not turn 15 years old prior to Jan. 1, 2014.

League play consists of a 14-game schedule beginning the week of April 16, running through the first week of July. Schedules will be provided at the league coaches' meeting the week of March 19, 2014.

League games will be played on Monday through Thursday, leaving weekends open for teams that want to play in out-of-town tournaments on their own. Make up games maybe rescheduled for weekends if both team are available. Teams must provide: team name, uniforms and their own equipment. Insurance and umpire fees covered by team registration fees. A coach from each team will be required to attend league meetings to review league rules, rainout and rescheduling procedures, as well as other items associated with league play. Games will be played at the Holcom Sports Complex.

Houk League — **U15** — Players can not turn 16 years old prior to Jan. 1, 2014. Individual entry.

Players are invited to attend an evaluation in April. Coaches will draft ALL players who sign up by the Tuesday, April 5, deadline. Those players who played on a Houk League team in 2013 may elect to stay with that team or re-enter the draft. Coaches may also elect to protect all or none of their players from their previous 2013 Houk League team roster. Games will begin in late May/early June and be completed by Aug. 1, 2014.

LAWRENCE GIRLS FAST PITCH ASSOCIATION SOFTBALL LEAGUES

LGFPFA has the following divisions: 8 years old and under (8U); 10 years old and under (10U); 12 years old and under (12U); 14 years old and under (14U) and 16 years old and under (16U). Teams for the 8U league will be formed by individual registration, while the remaining leagues — 10U, 12U, 14U and 16U — will be team registration only. The 8U league will have 10 to 12 games and will be machine pitch. The remaining leagues — 10U, 12U, 14U and 16U — will have 12 to 14 games and will be player pitch. A player's eligibility is determined by the age as of Jan. 1, 2012. Minimum of 4 teams per age division. LAWRENCE GIRLS FAST PITCH (LGFPFA)

U8 — Teams are formed by the coach. This is a machine pitch league. Players sign up individually and place coach's name on the registration form. Coach pays the deposit to secure a team spot in the league. Players must be 8 years of age or younger as of Jan. 1, 2014.

U10 — Coach pays the deposit to secure a team spot in the league. This is a "player pitch" league. Coaches will be given a roster form for them to fill out and return with final payment prior to the season. Roster form will include each player's name and parent's signature. Players must be 10 years of age or younger as of Jan. 1, 2014.

U12 — Coach pays the deposit to secure a team spot in the league. This is a "player pitch" league. Coaches will be given a roster form for them to fill out and return with final payment prior to the season. Roster form will include each player's name and parent's signature. Players must be 12 years of age or younger as of Jan. 1, 2014.

U14 — Coach pays the deposit to secure a team spot in the league. This is a "player pitch" league. Coaches will be given a roster form for them to fill out and return with final payment prior to the season. Roster form will include each player's name and parent's signature. Players must be 14 years of age or younger as of Jan. 1, 2014.
