

Neighborhood Update for LAN April 2010

Item #1: Text Amendments

The following text amendment updates have been provided by Planning and Development Services.

Adaptive Reuse - scheduled to be considered by the HRC in April.

<u>Boarding House</u> - PC direction provided to staff at March meeting. Revisions are likely to be submitted to PC in May.

<u>Hotel use in IL</u> – PC recommended adding the hotel use to the IL district at their March meeting. A staff recommendation to include the hotel use in the IBP district was also favorably recommended but will be detached from the IL amendment because of inadequate legal notification. Staff will submit a recommendation to initiate the hotel use in the IBP district to the PC for their April meeting. <u>Text Amendment notice</u> – the PC directed staff to provide them information related to enhanced notice of text amendments to the Development Code. A memo on this matter will likely be submitted to the PC in May.
