

Neighborhood Update for LAN February 2011

Item #1: Sidewalk Snow Removal Information

The Code Enforcement Division of the Planning and Development Services Department would like to remind property owners of their responsibility to remove snow or ice from public sidewalks adjacent to their property. In December 2008, the City amended the snow removal ordinance to shorten the compliance time period to clear snow/ice from sidewalks. The ordinance requires property owners to remove snow or ice from the sidewalk 48 hours after the cessation of accumulation. City staff enforces the ordinance through citizen complaints and citations are issued to property owners who are in violation.

The City of Lawrence believes safe pedestrian walkways in the winter season are an important element in maintaining a walkable city. For those citizens who are unable to clear their sidewalk; the City of Lawrence has joined with the Douglas County Senior Services to match residents needing assistance with volunteers who want to do a neighborly good deed.
