Horizon 2020 – Chapter 11: Historic Resources – to Planning Commission in June.

Horizon 2020 – Chapter 16: Environment Chapter (adopted by the Planning Commission and the Board of County Commissioners) – to City Commission on June 7, 2011.

Northeast Sector Plan (adopted by the Planning Commission) – to Board of County Commissioners on June 1, 2011

Item #3: CDD Information

In July, the Community Development Division will begin taking applications for the Comprehensive Rehabilitation Housing Program. The Comprehensive Rehabilitation Housing Program is a loan program that provides no interest loans for housing rehabilitation to low and moderate income households throughout Lawrence. These projects are not limited to the neighborhoods that receive CDBG funding. The projects have a limit of \$25,000 and the funds are used to make repairs necessary to bring the property into compliance with local codes and department property rehabilitation standards.
