Item #2: City of Lawrence Subscription Services

Item #3: CDD Information

The Community Development Division ended their Comprehensive Rehabilitation Program application process on March 1, and received a total of 46 applications. Staff is beginning the process of reviewing and ranking the applications and will begin contacting applicants for further information as they move through the process. The projects have a limit of \$25,000 and the funds are used to make repairs necessary to bring the property into compliance with local codes and department property rehabilitation standards.

The Community Development Advisory Committee has begun their funding allocation deliberations for the 2010 CDBG/HOME program year. The Public Hearing is scheduled for April 8, at which time the Annual Action Plan and the Investment Summary will be available for comment.
