The Community Development Advisory Committee will hold their Public Hearing on April 14, 2011 at 6:00pm in the City Commission Room. The Committee will take public comment at that time regarding the 2011 Annual Action Plan and the 2011 Recommended CDBG/HOME allocations. The Annual Action Plan draft copy will be available for review on the department website at the beginning of April.

There are two At Large positions available on the Community Development Advisory Committee. These positions have no neighborhood affiliation requirement. Any citizen can apply for the At Large positions if they are not in a low-moderate income area, which is generally anything west of lowa Street with a few exceptions.
