Item #1: City of Lawrence Subscription Services

Item #2: CDD Information

The Community Development Advisory Committee has two openings for appointments to the committee. The open position is for a low-moderate income area representative. The appointee must come from an area that is 51% or more low-mod and is not already geographically represented on the committee. The Community Development Advisory Committee (CDAC) has started the 2013 CDBG/HOME allocation process. Meetings are held the second and fourth Thursday of each month in the City Commission Room, from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm.

Margene Swarts, Assistant Director of Planning and Development Services, has announced her retirement plans after 33 years with the City of Lawrence. Her last day will be March 22. Margene has worked with CDBG and HOME since 1989. A community reception will be held Wednesday, March 20, 2013 at the Lawrence Arts Center from 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm.

Item #4: Project Updates

- 1. <u>Occupancy</u> The Planning Commission heard this item and recommended approval of the change to detached dwelling occupancy down to 3 unrelated generally in all districts except for the RM Districts. This item will tentatively be at the City Commission on March 26th.
- 2. <u>Transportation 2040</u> –A draft of this plan is available for public comment through March 16th at http://www.lawrenceks.org/mpo/t2040. The final draft of the document will be presented to the Lawrence-Douglas County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Policy Board for approval on the March 21st.

- 3. <u>Oread Design Guidelines</u> Staff is working on the draft document and will soon begin meeting the appointed PC and HRC members to review. A joint meeting with the PC and HRC will occur this spring to introduce the draft to both commissions before public hearings on the rezonings (guidelines) and text amendments.
- 4. <u>Downtown Redevelopment Issues Memo</u> The HRC and PC have received the memo and have planned a joint meeting on Wednesday, March 13th at 7:30 am in the City Commission Room (PC Mid-Month) to discuss the recommendations outlined in the report.

TA-12-00204: Consider a Text Amendment to the City of Lawrence Land Development Code, Chapter 20, to establish lighting standards and requirements as an alternative to the photometric plan. *Initiated by City Commission on 8/21/12*. **MM**

TA-13-00035: Consider a Text Amendment to Section 12-319-1 of the Zoning Regulations of the Unincorporated Territory of Douglas County to include Nanobrewery in the list of uses permitted with Conditional Uses and to establish any necessary standards for the use. *Initiated by Planning Commission on 1/30/13*. **MM**
