

Neighborhood Update for LAN September 2010

Item #1: Planning Updates

Text amendments:

Boarding House – The Planning Commission will continue discussing boarding houses at their September regular meeting in order to give staff direction on draft language.

Subdivision Regulations – The Planning Commission will consider revising the subdivision regulations for platting that will return the process to a more conventional one of dedicating rights-of-way and easements at the plat stage instead of the preliminary plat stage. Several other platting elements will be proposed for revision, including permitting some level of flexibility between preliminary and final platting.

RM32 Density – The Planning Commission discussed the concepts of increasing or lifting the density cap in RM32. Staff will prepare language for the PC's consideration at a future meeting.

Hotel/Motel use in IBP – The Planning Commission will consider use standards to ensure compatibility with RS zoning for hotels/motels in the IBP district, as directed by the City Commission.

Industrial Design Guidelines – The Planning Commission is tentatively scheduled to hear draft industrial design guidelines at their October meeting pending completion of the draft by staff.
