- We kept our membership informed of the planning and deliberations of the School Consolidation Working Committee and USD497 School Board, as our neighborhood elementary school is a focal issue for us.
- We were able to fill our neighborhood coordinator position, hiring Erika O'Shea. Erika immediately shouldered many tasks related to planning our biggest annual outreach event – the potluck picnic!

- In late April some of our neighbors gathered for a morning walk around the streets and sidewalks of our neighborhood. Results of this infrastructure survey will be used to request specific improvements to our streets, storm water system, and sidewalks.
