We are very happy to say that we walked almost the entire neighborhood. There is still a small portion that we will tackle next year; but 95% of a neighborhood of 1500+ households isn't bad in a little under a year a quarter (including months for winter). I am extremely proud our neighborhood and the way that it stepped up to meet the challenge.

This September, we were joined by our Chief of Police, Gregory Burns for a Walk Pinckney. I loved the dual benefit of the people walking and that we were meeting getting to know one of our city's leaders. Hopefully, we can get additional leaders to accompany us next year.

Overall, I think the program has met its intended goal of better outreach, increased attendance for Pinckney events, activate participation, and to foster a better understanding of Pinckney and our intergral parts in it.

We've approved our new Neighborhood Plan and this quarter have developed a Working Group to implement portions of it. We feel that's best way to keep the plan 'alive' so that it doesn't go stagnant for another 40 years. Our subsequent Work Group meetings have been highly productive and we been able to implement some ideas and plan for the future. Due to group, we had a successful Neighborhood movie night and more trunks that we've ever had for Trunk or Treat.

We continued to increase the visibility of the neighborhood with our annual Neighborhood Garage Sale. Next year we hope to have event more participants. Also, we had another stellar year for Trunk or Treat. We had ever more trunks and sponsor this year. Our participation was similar or even a little more. Lawrence Memorial Hospital (LMH) was able to participate again this year and I'm sure that contributed to the great event. We hope to have even more next year!
