There is a 30-day mandatory waiting period before any demolition work can begin. Expiration of the mandatory waiting period, along with verification from gas, electric, and water utility providers that services have been retired is necessary before a permit will be issued. This application must be signed by the record owner(s) and any contract purchaser(s).

No demolition permit may be issued for the demolition of a building or structure which is a landmark or within the area of an Historic District, or their environs; or, a nominated landmark or a key contributing or contributing building or structure within a nominated Historic District unless the applicant shall have first obtained a Certificate of Appropriateness or Certificate of Economic Hardship for such demolition from the Historic Resources Commission.

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
