I am writing to you as the Chair of the Lawrence Affordable Housing Coalition. [I have blind cc'ed the entire steering committee so that no one inadvertently hits "reply all" and accidentally violates the Kansas Open Meeting Act.]

Our coalition was both heartened and disheartened to see in the ETC survey that affordable housing was listed as a top concern to our community. "Heartened" in that we do indeed have a similar community-wide concern, and "disheartened" that the issue even exists. Our coalition has circulated a petition with 251 signers asking the Horizon 2020 Steering Committee for the following:

"Lawrence is one of the most expensive places to live in Kansas, and we also earn less than most other Kansas communities. We the undersigned ask the Horizon 2020 Steering Committee to add affordable housing goals and solutions to the updated Horizon 2020 plan, as well as to its mission statement. An affordable housing chapter would include topics such as limiting gentrification of older neighborhoods, ensuring greater variety in housing types built, and addressing transitional housing and "aging in place" issues.
