

Trash Collection

Additional Information

Guidelines

- Set out trash in the cart provided by the City by 7:00 a.m. on your designated trash collection day. Make sure the cart lid is closed. Remove empty carts from the curb within 24 hours.
- Place the cart within 3 feet of the street or alley. Do not block sidewalks or driveways. Maintain a clear path to the cart and keep cart at least 3 feet away from other carts, mailboxes, low hanging tree branches, parked cars or utility poles so trucks can easily access the cart.
- Carts that exceed the weight limits indicated on the lid cannot be picked up. Loading carts with sod, rocks, or bricks may overload the cart and cause damage.
- Sawdust, fireplace ashes (cool for one week), cat litter, sweeping compounds, shredded paper, facial tissues, packaging materials and other loose material must be in sealed in boxes or bags and then placed inside the trash cart to prevent litter when containers are emptied by the collectors.
- Place household sharps (e.g. needles) in a puncture proof container such as an old detergent bottle or coffee can. Secure lid with tape, label the container "sharps" and place inside the trash cart.
- Improper disposal of hazardous materials can cause pollution and endanger the health and safety of our Solid Waste employees. Do not place household hazardous waste (e.g. paint, cleaners, pesticides, fluorescent lamps) or used motor oil in the trash cart. Call 832-3030 for proper disposal.
- Do not set out yard waste with trash when separate yard waste collection is available; starting Mondays in March through mid-December (weather permitting, excluding holidays). Yard waste includes leaves, grass clippings, garden waste, brush and trimmings from trees and shrubs.

Submit a pickup service request form online at www.lawrenceks.org/swm for the following items:

- Bulky items. Any bulky item that does not fit in the trash cart (e.g. appliances, furniture).
- Carpet. Limit 8 rolls per household per year. Carpet rolls must be no longer than 5 feet long and must be 18 inches in diameter or less.
- Tires. Limit 5 tires per household per year.
- Construction, remodeling, or building materials. This type of material must be disposed of in a roll-off box. Fees apply. See *Container Rentals* section below.

Residential Trash Collection

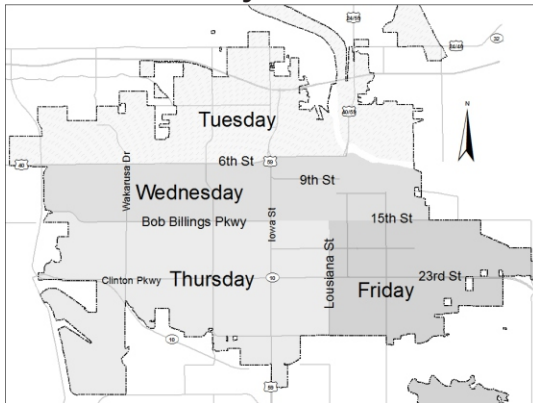
The City of Lawrence begins residential trash collection service at 7 a.m.

Containers

All trash must be placed in the roll-out cart provided by the city. Please do not pack cart so tightly that trash becomes stuck and will not empty. To request a different size cart or additional carts, please complete the online form at www.lawrenceks.org/carts or call the Solid Waste Division at 832-3032.

Residential Weekly Collection Schedule



Monday See "Yard Waste Collection" at right.

Tuesday

- North Lawrence (north & east of Kansas River).
- North of 6th St.

Wednesday

- South of 6th St & north of Bob Billings Pkwy./15th St.

Thursday

- South of Bob Billings Pkwy./15th St. from Louisiana St. west to the City Limits.

Friday

- South of 15th St. from Louisiana St. east to the City Limits.

Services

Automobile Tires & Bulky Items

Five passenger tires per household per year picked up free. Additional/oversized tires accepted for a small charge. Many tire retailers will also accept waste tires for a small fee. Bulky Items include refrigerators, washers, dryers, hide-a-beds, etc. Curbside collection by appointment only. *Schedule a pickup using the online form at www.lawrenceks.org/swm.*

Carpet and Padding

Eight rolls of carpet and padding per household per year are picked up free. Carpet and padding need to be bundled in 5' or shorter lengths and no wider than 18" in diameter, weighing up to 65 lbs. Additional rolls will be charged a \$2.00 fee. *Schedule a pickup using the online form at www.lawrenceks.org/swm.*

Household Hazardous Waste

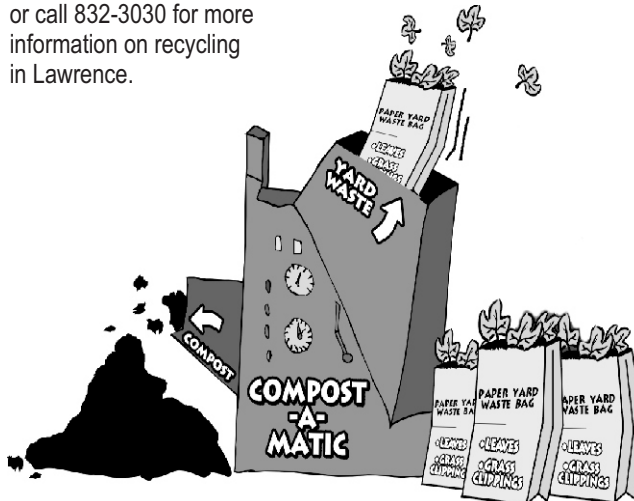
Drop off unwanted automotive products, household cleaning products, paints & hobby supplies, pest control products, etc. *Call 832-3030 to schedule a drop-off appointment.*

Household Sharps Disposal

Household sharps such as needles should be packaged in a puncture proof container (detergent bottle, coffee can, etc.) with a secure taped lid for trash pick-up. Please label the container "Sharps".

Yard Waste Collection

Lawrence Composts

Mulch mowing, backyard composting, and Monday yard waste collection are all ways to return your excess plant materials to the earth. Curbside collection is seasonal (March-December, weather permitting, excluding holidays) and is for grass, leaves and brush. If using a lawn herbicide, please ensure it does not contain any persistent chemicals, which could outlast the composting process (approximately 90 days) and later may damage sensitive plants. If using such a product, please mulch mow your clippings. *Call 832-3030 with any questions.*

Materials should be set out by 6:00 a.m. in a **can, City cart (trash cart or yard waste cart), or compostable paper yard waste bag** for Monday yard waste collection. Bundles of tree and brush trimmings are also accepted. Must not exceed 5 feet in length nor 18 inches in diameter and must not weigh more than 65 pounds. Bundles must be tied with string or twine only.

No yard waste container should weigh more than 65 pounds, unless it is a wheeled City cart. Material should not extend more than 12 inches above the top of the container.

Yard Waste Carts

95-gallon yard waste carts are available for purchase to be used for Monday curbside yard waste collection, no trash. 330 pound capacity, easy mobility, weatherproof, and side vents to prevent strong odors from stored material. \$60 each. *Visit www.lawrenceks.org/swm to order yours.*

Christmas Trees

Seasonal only. Curbside collection. Trees will be used for wildlife habitat. All artificial items, including tinsel, lights and stands must be removed in advance of pick up. *Schedule available at www.lawrenceks.org/swm.*
